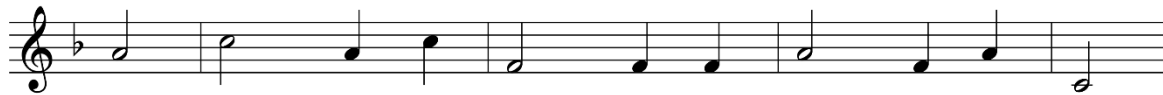

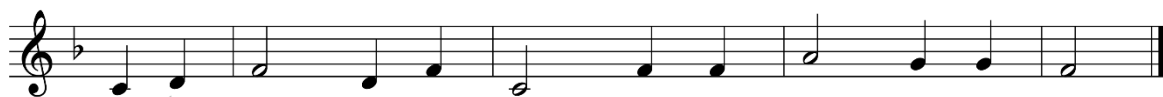

and life everlasting. Amen.**

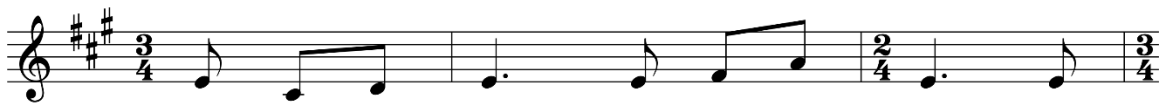
