



Annual Easter Basket Service Project 2021

We are once again kicking off the Annual Easter Basket Project to help families in need this Lenten season. This project has been an annual tradition since STB began.

This year we will be utilizing [Sign Up Genius](#) for you to choose how to help.

There are 2 different ways to help.

1. The first way is there are gift cards needed for Cub, Target or Holiday Gas stations. Please sign up for a card and drop off at church anytime **before March 14th** and drop in the box near the basement steps.
2. The second is make an "Easter Basket" The baskets are large plastic storage tubs with lids (Target is a great place to get these) and filled with household goods (toilet paper, laundry soap, cleaning supplies) and food (packaged, cans) and toiletries (toothpaste, shampoo, lotions) and a few Easter touches or things for young children.

Once the baskets are finished, please tape the name and number to the top of the basket and drop off in the church basement by March 14th. If doing a "general" family basket without a specific number, please write General Family Basket on the sheet and tape to the top of the basket.

One of the agencies receiving the baskets is CAPS in Rosemount supporting working families that live below the poverty line. The others are going to the Visitation sisters of North Minneapolis who serve their neighbors in need. These baskets have specific numbers and names and can be a little more customized.

The needs are great this year, if using Sign Up Genius is a barrier, please just buy a \$25 gift card to Target, Cub or Holiday Gas Station and drop off at church. Every card matters.
