



**Did you know that proper medication disposal is an environmental issue as well as a health and public safety one?**

Unused medications should not be placed in the trash. They should also never be poured down a sink or flushed down a toilet. Any of these methods introduce them into our water stream. All prescription, over-the-counter, and pet medications in pill, liquid, cream, spray or powder form should be brought to any of the local police stations: Eagan, Inver Grove Heights, Mendota Heights, and Rosemount.

Medication should either be in its original container with your name crossed out or in a clear plastic bag. Vials, IV bags, EpiPens, inhalers and patches are also accepted.
