Thank You St. Thomas Becket Parish is very grateful to our parishioners who came forward to help package meals for the recently held Feed My Starving Children South of the River Project at Berean Baptist Church in Burnsville.

About one third of our 97 volunteers who had signed up were able to make it either on Tuesday, February 5th or Thursday, February 7th. This was due to the extremely challenging road conditions both evenings. For those unable to make it, thank you for your intentions to help and we acknowledge that your safety is our number one priority. The parish is also thankful to those who gave a financial donation to Feed My Starving Children. This money is used to buy food supplies and to help with shipping costs. Over \$800 was raised!

If any family still wishes to contribute a financial donation – especially those who were unable to attend physically - checks made out to St. Thomas Becket with the memo: FMSC – South Metro can be dropped off at the parish office at any time during office hours or put in the collection basket. In spite of the ice, snow, mini-polar vortex and more snow, 1,415,448 meals were packed, and 3,878 kids will be fed for one year!

Our parish was joined by hundreds of others from over 20 churches and organizations. Churches of different sizes, denominations, theologies, all worked together towards a goal that is bigger than any one church – engaging in God’s world to make a huge difference for so many people!
