With Dr. Mark Seeley | U of MN Climatologist, Author, Radio Personality

Dr. Mark Seeley, well-known radio personality and University of Minnesota meteorologist and climatologist, will be speaking on the topic of Climate Change in Our Own Backyard. Dr. Seeley was Extension Climatologist at the U of M from 1978 through 2018 and has extensive knowledge of climate history in our home state.

He is a fascinating and well-liked speaker having participated in thousands of public speaking engagements, meetings, media interviews and person-to-person interactions where he shared his considerable knowledge of climate. He will include in his discussion the Fourth National Climate Assessment released by the Federal Government last November. Numerous exhibits from prominent environmental organizations will be on display in the commons before and after the presentation.
