Please keep an eye on the ivy (around the church) and the succulents in the ambulatories in addition to the seasonal flowers. It looks like we're getting a big fern.

Jan : Ann/Paul (White poinsettias will continue until they die)  
 Feb : Mary Jo/Michelle (White poinsettias still be hanging on)  
 March: Paul/Ann (Lent: February 26)  
 April: Michelle/Stacey watering lilies during Easter (April 12)  
 May: Paul/Mary Jo watering Easter flowers (Pentecost, May 31)  
 June: Stacey/\_\_\_\_\_  
 July: Paul/Ann  
 August: Michelle/ Mary Jo  
 Sept: Stacey/Paul watering mums (after Parish Picnic)  
 Oct: Michelle/Ann watering mums  
 Nov: \_\_\_\_\_/Mary Jo watering mums (until Nov. 24, Feast of Christ the King)  
 Dec: Stacey/Ann watering poinsettias the week after Christmas (probably once)
