Disciple Maker Index Survey

We are asking for your help by completing the “Disciple Maker Index Survey” as part of the Archdiocesan Synod process.

What Is It? This is a **confidential** 10-15-minute survey from the Archdiocese to help Archbishop Hebda have a better understanding of the needs of both the parish and the diocese.

How do I complete the survey? There are two ways to complete the survey. The easiest way is to follow this link and complete it on-line. The link is www.DiscipleMakerIndex.com.

You also can fill out the survey in writing. Copies will be available after mass or in the office. Once completed, please put them in the box marked “COMPLETED DISCIPLE MAKER SURVEYS” outside the office door. We will mail them to the Archdiocese.

THE SURVEY IS ONLY AVAILABLE FROM FEBRUARY 1 – MARCH 1. It is a short window, so please consider completing the survey soon.

We have two additional requests:

1. We would like to have as many parishioners as possible, at least 18 years old, answer the survey and do so honestly. You have heard this before, but there are no wrong answers if you truly believe in your response.
2. If you know someone who used to attend St. Thomas Becket and has fallen away from the church, please ask them to complete the survey as well.

All responses are confidential. I and the parish will only receive information about the Community of St. Thomas Becket. The information will be valuable for the parish as it seeks ways to best support everyone in their faith journey.

We have a goal of **500 responses** that we would like to see submitted from our parishioners. We have asked if there is a way to get updates from the diocese on a weekly basis and will pass on the numbers if we are able to do so.
